Minnesota Opera opens its 2016-2017 season with Romeo & Juliet

Former Resident Artist Angela Mortellaro and Joshua Dennis star as opera's classic lovers in Gounod's lush, Shakespeare adaptation

MINNEAPOLIS (September 1, 2016) – Minnesota Opera kicks off its 2016-2017 season at the Ordway Music Theater on September 24, 2016, with a new production of Charles Gounod's tragic – yet meltingly beautiful – masterpiece: Romeo & Juliet. Vibrant young singers, opulent costumes, and striking sets breathe new life into the world's most famous story of star-crossed lovers.

"William Shakespeare's Romeo & Juliet has been the inspiration for numerous works in several genres, including art, music, opera, ballet, musical theater and film," said Minnesota Opera President and General Director Ryan Taylor. "As we approach a new production of Gounod's classic retelling, I am most excited to see how this ingenious group of artists, under the leadership of celebrated young stage director Matthew Ozawa, brings new life to this ever-appealing story."

Juliette, daughter of the Capulets, has fallen in love with Roméo, scion of the Montague family, but their two families are embroiled in enmity and hatred. Roméo and Juliette's transcendent love triumphs as they die together in an immortal embrace. Perhaps the most enduringly successful of the many operatic settings of the world's consummate love story, Gound's Romeo & Juliet values subtlety, sensuality and graceful vocal delivery over showy effects. In this telling, there is a slight shift of focus away from the word games of the original play and a greater focus on the two lovers, who are given four irresistible duets, including a brief final reunion in the tomb scene that does not appear in the play.

Former Resident Artist Angela Mortellaro, who delivered a captivating performance in Minnesota Opera's 2014 production of *Hansel and Gretel*, returns to the company to sing the iconic role of Juliette. Described as "beautiful to watch on stage" by the *Portland Press Herald*, Ms. Mortellaro's richness of voice, skillful delivery of dazzling vocal pyrotechnics, and innate acting ability have kept her in high demand. She has appeared with prestigious opera companies all over the U.S., including Opera Philadelphia and Sarasota Opera.

Ms. Mortellaro stars opposite tenor Joshua Dennis, who sings the title role of Roméo. Possessing a tenor voice *The New York Times* declared as filled with "youthful ardor," *Romeo & Juliet* marks Mr. Dennis' Minnesota Opera debut. He has previously sung with Arizona Opera, Michigan Opera Theater, Santa Fe Opera, Opera Idaho and Dallas Opera.

Music Director Michael Christie returns for his fifth season to conduct the Minnesota Opera Orchestra.
