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MINNESOTA OPERA TO OPEN 2024-2025 SEASON WITH GOUNOD'S *ROMEO AND JULIET*

Operatic adaption of Shakespeare's classic to feature in-demand tenor and MN native Evan LeRoy Johnson in company debut opposite audience favorite Jasmine Habersham in title roles

MINNEAPOLIS (October 1, 2024) – Minnesota Opera will open the 2024-2025 season, the 62nd in company history, with a production of Charles Gounod's paragon of French grand opera, *Romeo and Juliet*. Adapted from William Shakespeare's original tragedy, this enduring tale of star-crossed lovers will be brought to life on the operatic stage at the **Ordway Center for the Performing Arts** in downtown Saint Paul, running from **Saturday, November 2 through Sunday, November 10**. Gounod's evocative score, paired with libretto by Jules Barbier and Michael Carré, tells the musical story of Romeo and Juliet, two young lovers who long to be together despite a raging feud between their respective families.

When MN Opera originally staged this production in 2016 under the direction of **Matthew Ozawa**, it was noted for its minimalistic yet powerful design. Cincinnati Opera re-staged *Romeo and Juliet* in 2019 after coming onboard as a co-producer, hiring Ozawa and his team to expand upon their concept by creating additional scenic elements while remaining committed to the understated elegance that attracted audiences to the original. Since then, this production has become one of MN Opera's most popular rentals by other opera companies around the United States.

"Romeo and Juliet has endured the test of time because it tells a deeply human story of love, division, and tragedy that feels eternally relevant for all of us," says President and General Director **Ryan Taylor**. "This haunting and moving production, which is near and dear to our company, explores those themes in a powerful way."

Singing the role of Romeo will be tenor, Minnesota native, and Project Opera alum Evan LeRoy Johnson, making his company debut opposite soprano Jasmine Habersham (Edward Tulane), singing Juliet. They will be joined by two former MN Opera Resident Artists baritone Charles H. Eaton (La bohème) and mezzo-soprano Victoria Vargas (Edward Tulane) as well as bass Adam Lau in his company debut as Friar Laurent, Nathan Romportl (The Song Poet) as Benvolio, and baritone Philip Zawisza (The Manchurian Candidate) as the Duke of Verona. Romeo and Juliet will also showcase the MN Opera debuts of incoming Resident Artists, with Minnesota native and mezzo-soprano Kara Morgan singing Stephano, bass John Mburu singing Count Capulet, baritone Ángel Vargas as Tybalt, and baritone David Wolfe as Gregorio.

Composer Charles Gounod's *Romeo and Juliet* premiered in 1867 at the Théâtre Lyrique during the Paris Exposition Universelle and was extremely well received, selling out several performances. It was the second major operatic success for Gounod, who had collaborated with librettists Jules Barbier and Michael Carré on several works during the previous decade, including *Faust, Philémon*

et Baucis, and Mireille. Considered to be a prime example of French grand opera, Romeo and Juliet will feature the largest contingent of the MN Opera Chorus and MN Opera Orchestra of the entire season and will be led by Principal Conductor Christopher Franklin. Associate Stage Director and Company Artist Margaret Jumonville will stage Matthew Ozawa's original production, which features scenery by William Boles, costumes by Sarah Bahr, lighting by Paul Whitaker, and choreography by the James Sewell Ballet.

In addition to the performances at the Ordway, MN Opera will host an Offstage Event at MetroNOME Brewery in Saint Paul's Lowertown on Wednesday, October 30. The event will feature Jasmine Habersham sharing wisdom and stories from her history with MN Opera and her career more broadly. Additionally, Joseph Li (VP, Artistic) will present Opera Insights in the Ordway's Target Atrium one hour prior to each performance, exploring Gounod's musical approach to the human inclinations toward love and violence as well as what the composer's work has to say about the forces that both drive us apart and bring us together.
